



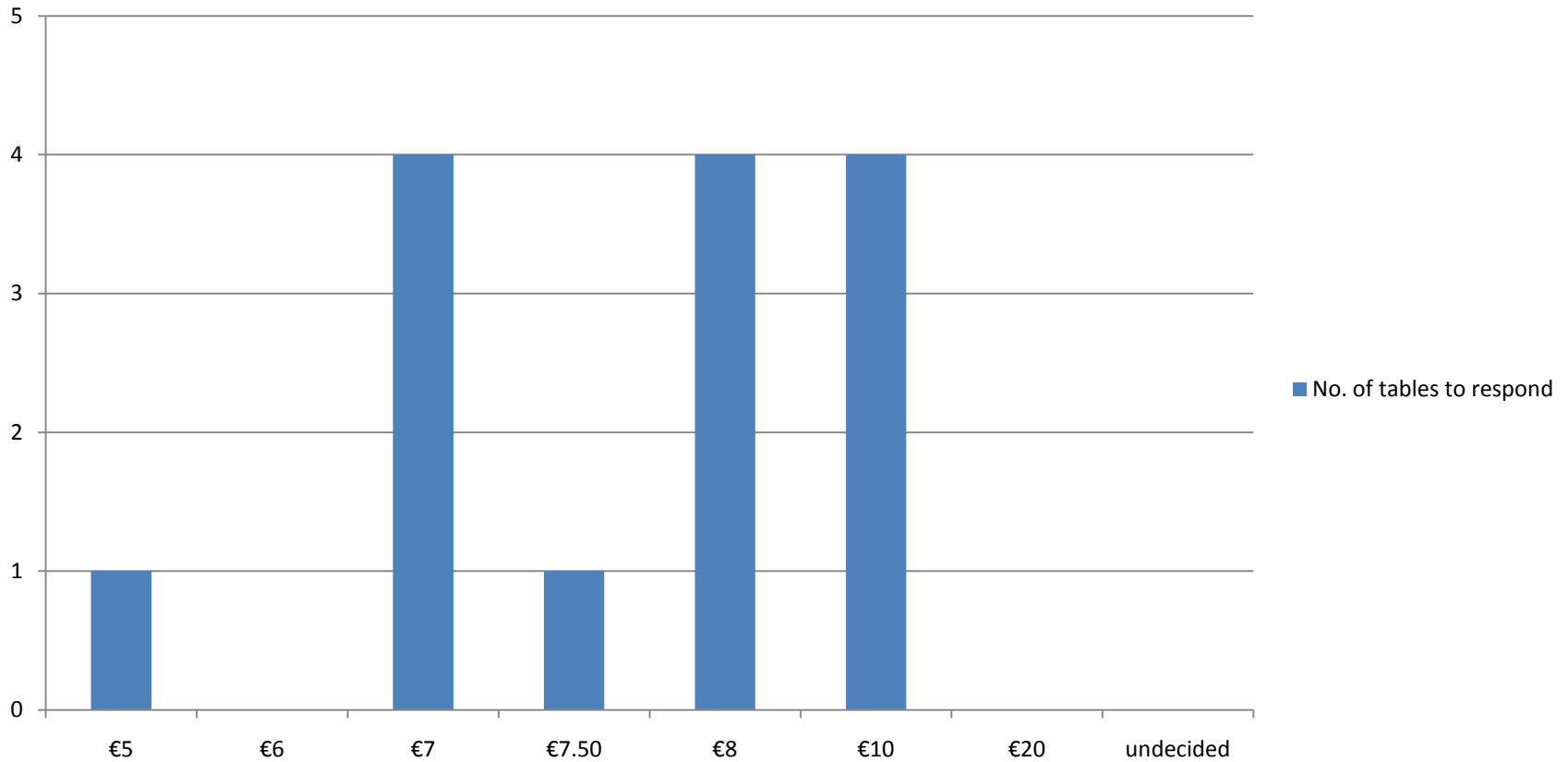

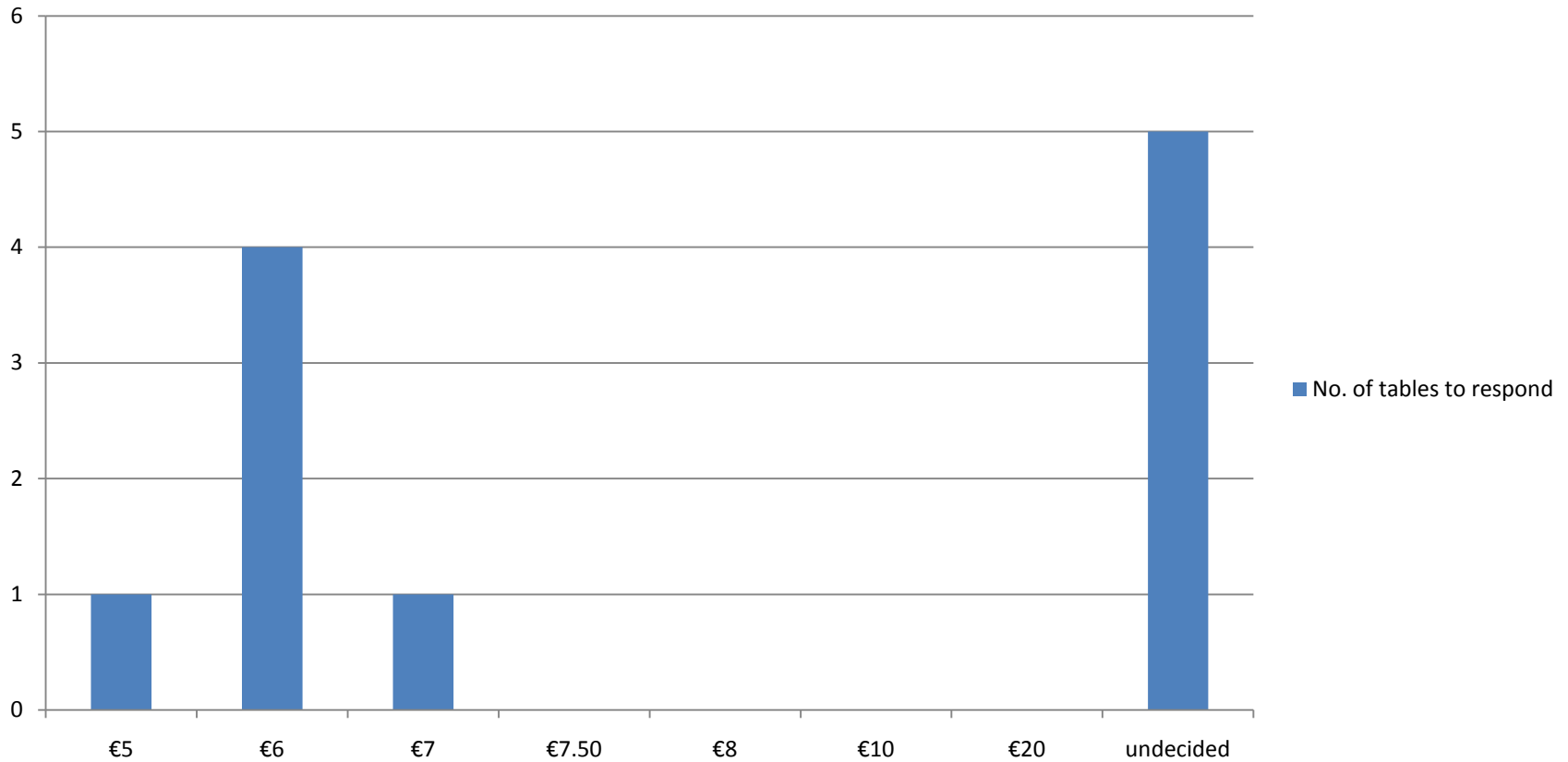
Mid West Region 14 Tables

No. of tables to respond



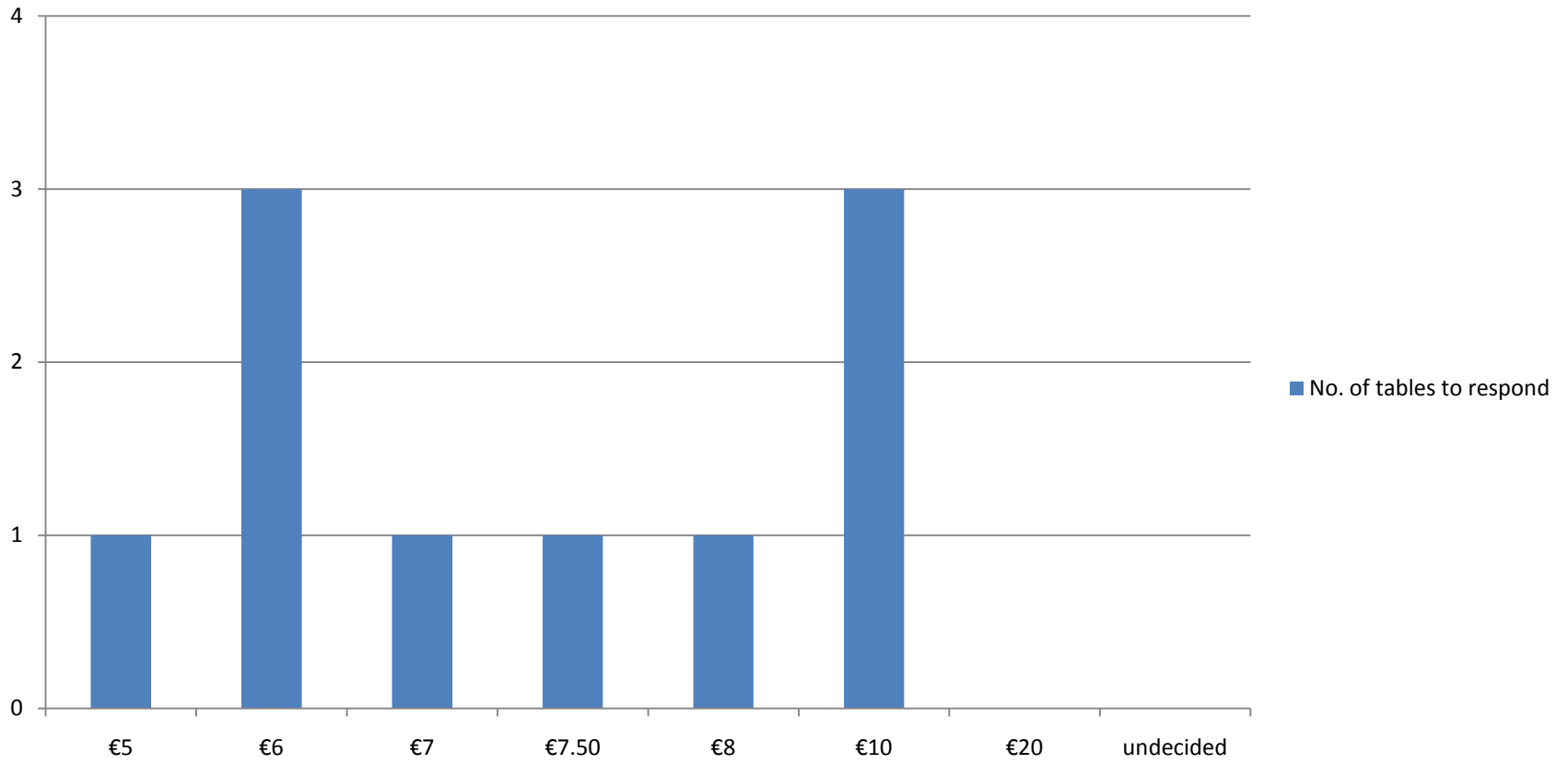
South East Region 11 tables

No. of tables to respond



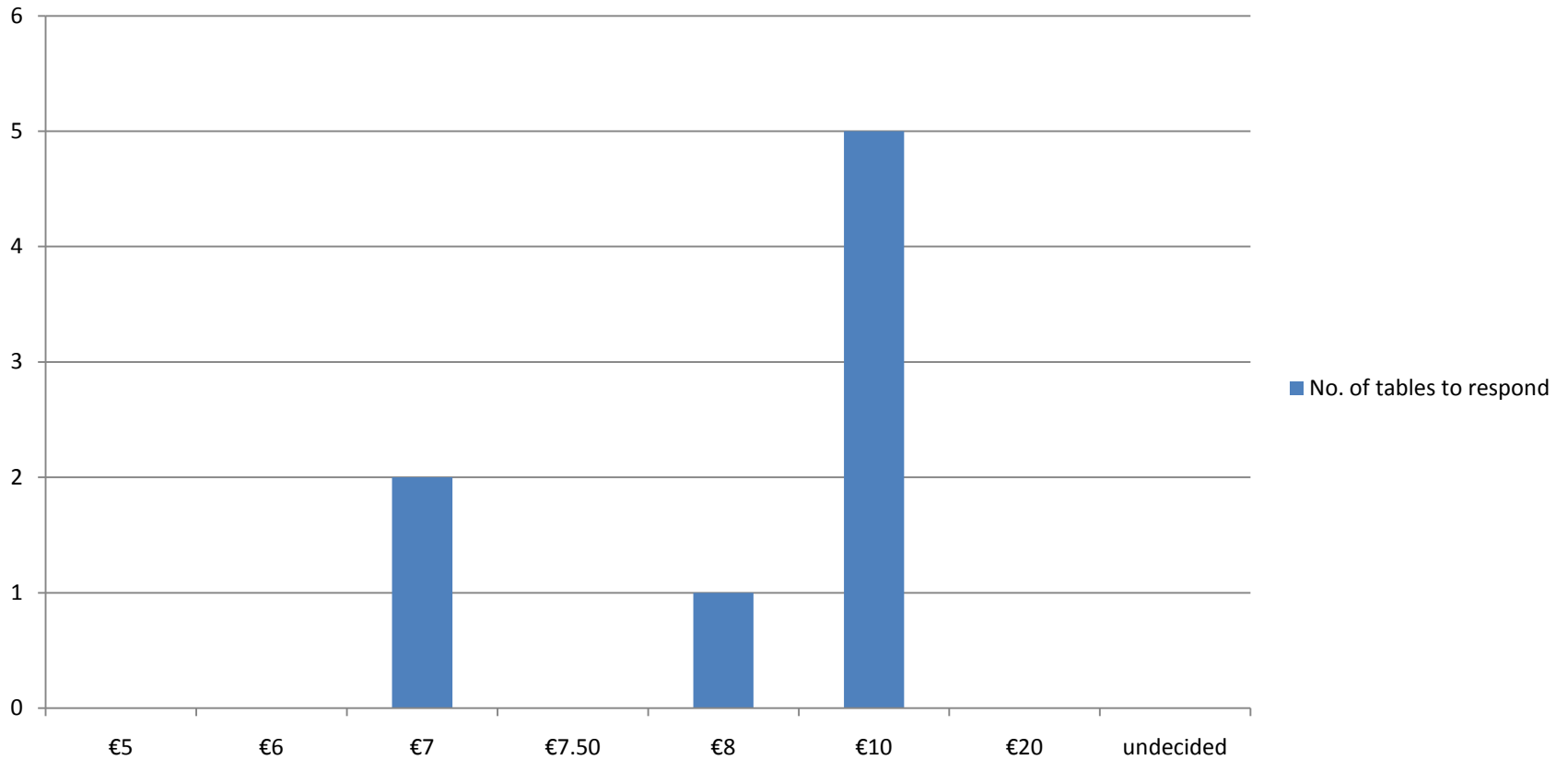
Eastern Region 10 tables

No. of tables to respond



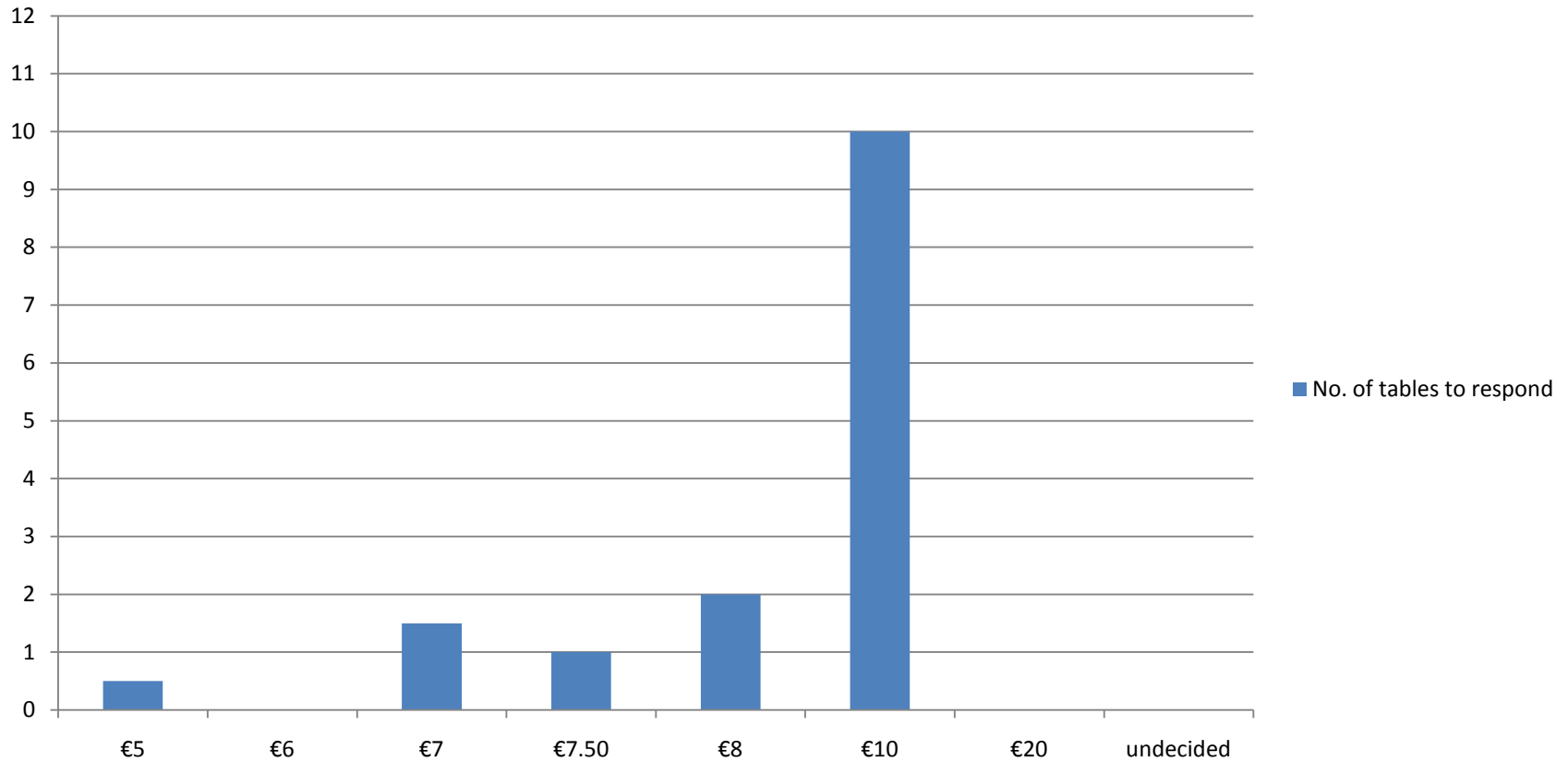
Southern Region 8 tables

No. of tables to respond



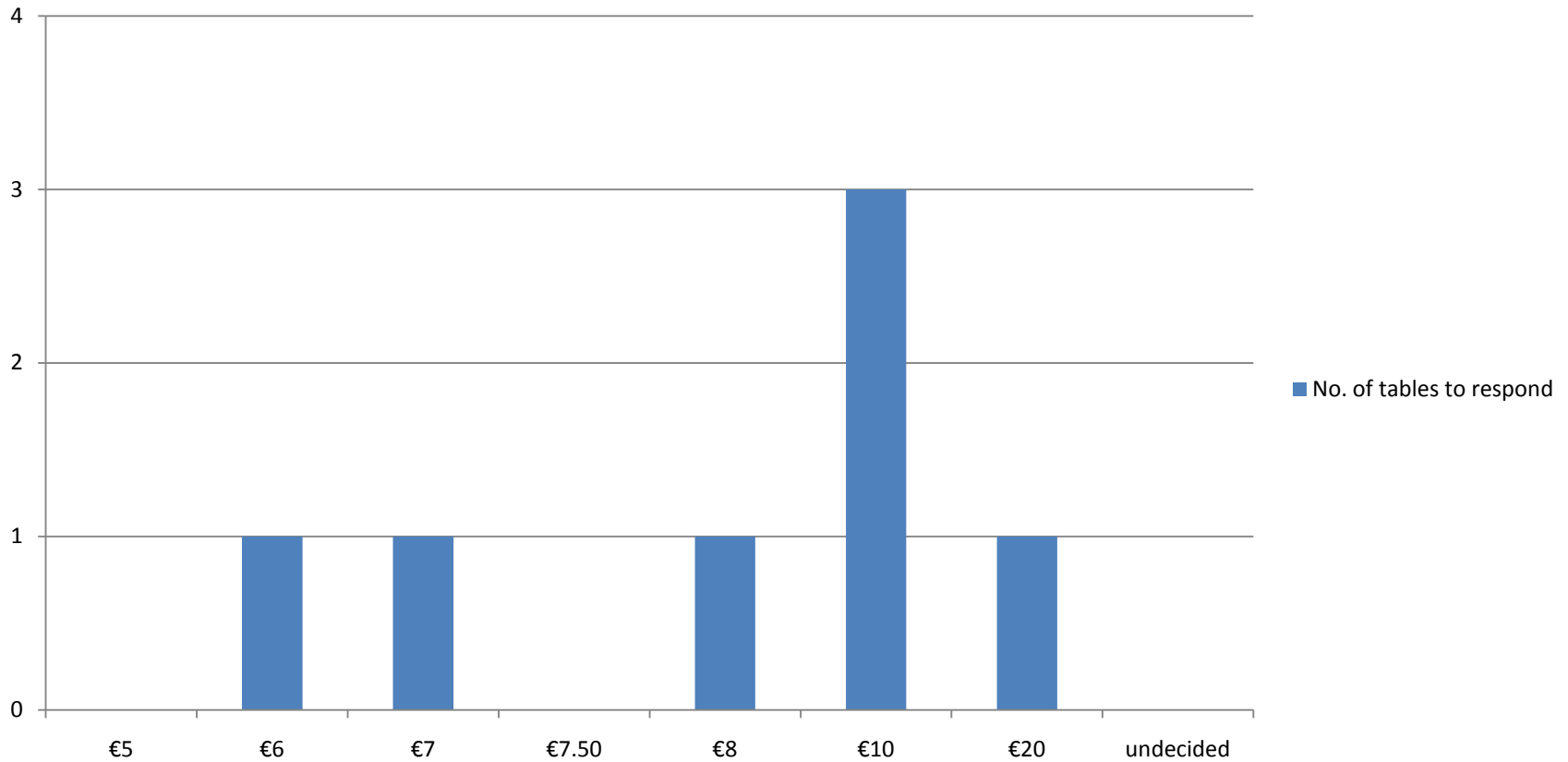
Western Region 15 tables

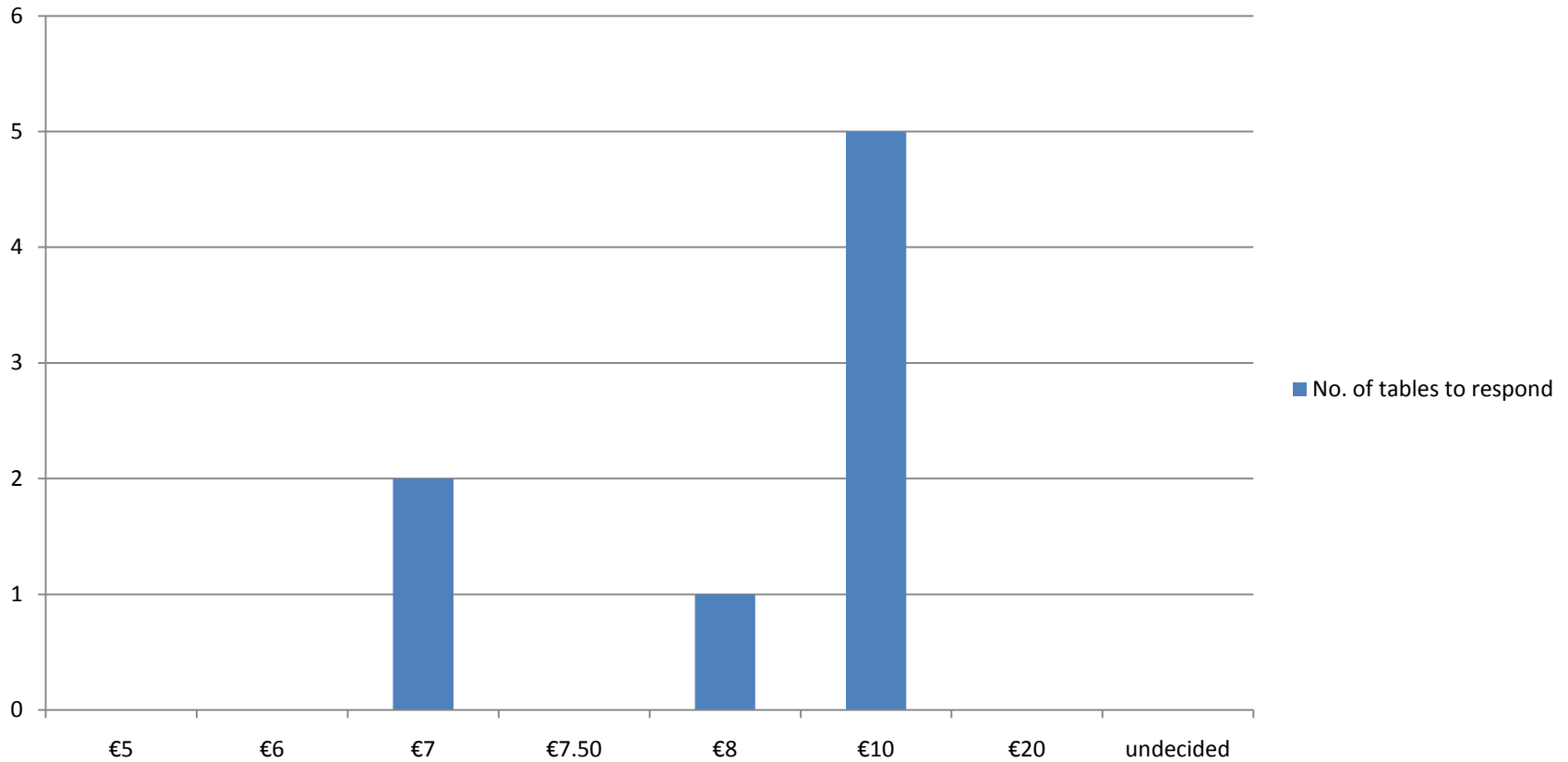
North West Region 7 tables

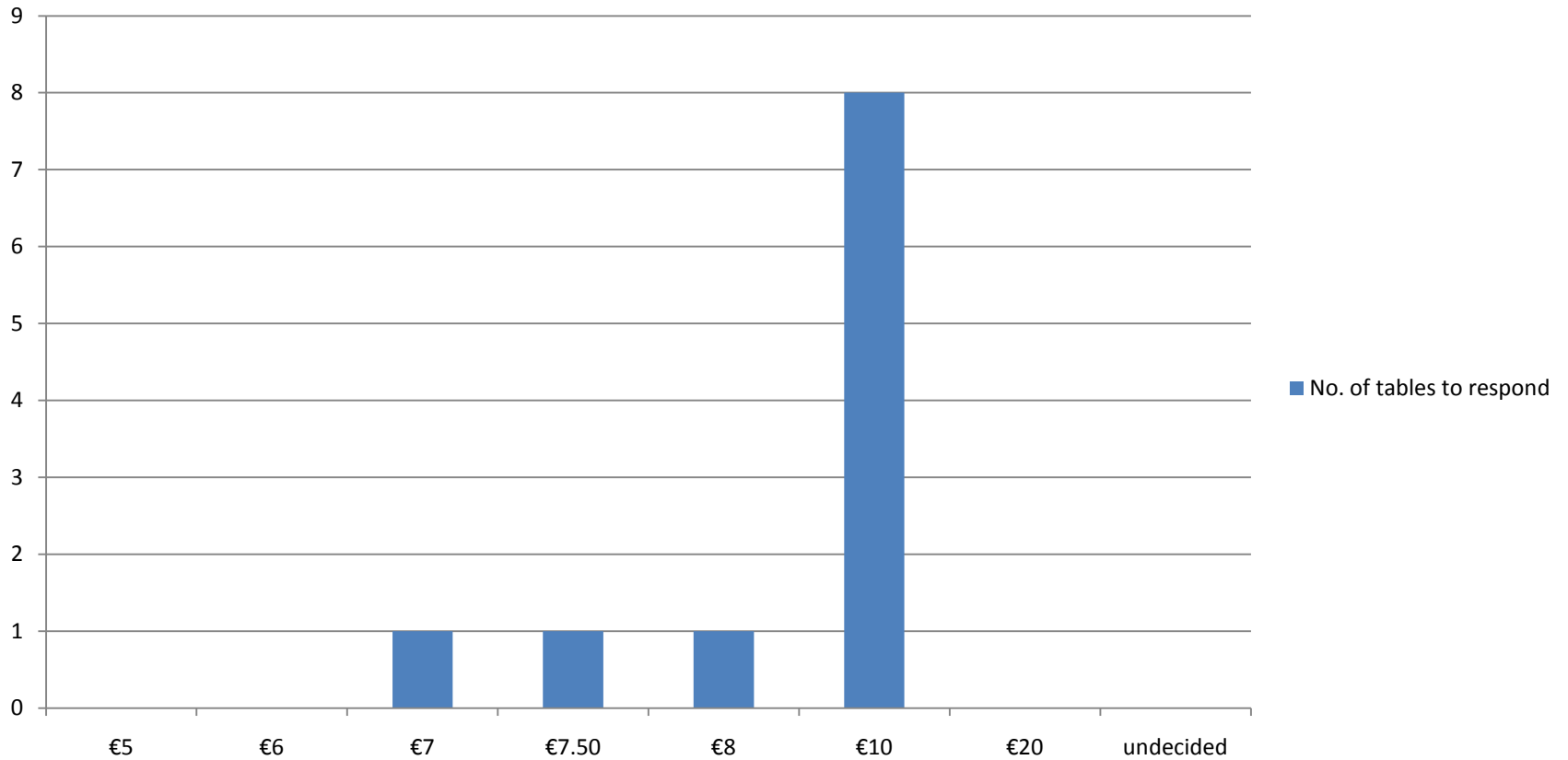

Summary of feedback

- 100% were in favour of a phased approach to increasing the fee
- Of the 8 regions 50% (4 regions) were unanimously in favour of increasing the fee
- In the Western region 3.3% which equates to 4 members felt that no fee increase was needed with 96.7% agreeing to an increase
- In Eastern region 10% disagreed with an increase this equates to 1 table which had only 5 members with 90% agreeing to an increase
- In the Mid West region 7.1% (1 table of 8 members) disagreed with an increase with 92.9% agreeing to an increase
- In the South East region 10% (1 table of 10) disagreed with an increase with 45% (5 tables) needing to consult with their ARAs and 45% agreeing to a phased increase
- **The following phased increase was deemed most appropriate**
2012 = €6; 2013 = €7; 2014 = €8; 2015 = €10

What happens next?

- ARAs will be sent this information and asked to discuss the issue of increasing the affiliation fee.
- An EGM will be called in the Autumn to make a final decision
